



MICHIGAN BLACK CAUCUS OF LOCAL ELECTED OFFICIALS BOARD OF DIRECTORS

The Michigan Black Caucus of Local Elected Officials was created to provide a forum for its members to collaborate, network, coach, mentor, share information, and provide support to one another in the State of Michigan. The caucus works in cooperation with the Michigan Municipal League (MML). Membership of MBC-LEO is comprised of local elected officials and municipal staff members and associates in the State of Michigan.

MBC-LEO is governed by a Board comprised of the president, first vice president, second vice president, secretary, chaplain, Fundraising Committee chairperson, Education/Program chairperson, and Information/Networking Committee chairperson.

Eligibility:

- Board members must be full members of MBC-LEO, defined as persons holding elected municipal positions such as mayor, council member, commissioner, or any similar position, and must be up to date on their membership dues.

Term:

- Each board member serves a two-year term.

Expectations and Responsibilities:

- Attend meetings in conjunction with League events:
 - MML Capital Conference, Lansing
 - MML Annual Convention, location varies
- Participate in scheduled Board meetings and special meetings as needed
- Attend all MBC-LEO-hosted events and forums

Application Process:

- A nominating committee, selected by the president from caucus membership, makes nominations to the board.
- Interested candidates may send a letter of interest to the Nominating Committee at nominations@mbc-leo.org.

Selection Process:

- Directors are elected biennially at the MBC-LEO Annual Meeting held during the MML Capital Conference via secret ballot by a majority vote of the caucus in attendance.
